AHMADIYYA MUSLIMS COMMUNITY

The key promoters of the Peace Symposium, the Sutton Ahmadiyya Muslim community are the largest and fastest growing single Muslim denomination in Sutton and have been leading a peaceful coexistence with other communities in Sutton for the last three decades. Its members have been proactively integrating within Sutton by fundraising and supporting local charities, holding weekly information stands in High Street and summer events, serving local voluntary organisations and serving as Elected Councillors in Sutton. It is the nature of its membership to build and live in cohesive societies and hence make them Ideal promoters of Peace Symposium in Sutton.

The Sutton Ahmadiyya Muslim Community is part of a dynamic, fast growing international revival movement within Islam. Founded in 1889, it spans over 200 countries with membership exceeding tens of millions. Its also the largest and fastest growing Muslim community in Sutton Borough with its Mosque (largest Mosque in Western Europe) at London Road (A24) at the border with Morden.

Established in the UK since 1913, we built London's first mosque in 1926 (The London Mosque in Putney). We now have 129 branches across Britain and have opened a number of mosques including the landmark Baitul Futuh mosque in south London, which is the largest in western Europe.

The Community has now built over 15,000 mosques, over 500 schools and over 30 hospitals and has translated the Holy Qur'an in over 70 languages. It propagates the true and welcoming teachings of Islam and the message of peace and tolerance through a 24-hour satellite television channel (MTA), the Internet (alislam.org) and print (Islam International Publications).
